TWENTY-FIRST GENERAL ORDER RE: MADERA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT MITIGATION OF THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the October 13, 2020 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the October 8, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Madera County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. With the concurrence of the Presiding Judge, the Court may order that sessions be held anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from October 15, 2020 to November 14, 2020, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));
- 2. In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire on from October 15, 2020, to November 14, 2020, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10); Executive Order N-38-20 (03/27/20)).; THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
