On order of the presiding judge, or his designee, session of this court may be held 17 anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from March 19, 18 2021 to April 18, 2021, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1)); 19 2. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from March 19, 2021 to April 18, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the court may extend 20 21 the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by 22 not more than 30 days.
