21	would expire from May 20, 2021 to June 19, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the court may		
22	extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a		
23	criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
