In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from July 21, 2021 to August 20, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the court may 20 extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a 21 criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)). 22 23 24 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY and any provision of the Thirty-First General Order not amended herein remains in effect. 25 26
