13	Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the October 15, 2021 request for an
14	emergency order made by the Superior Court of Madera County ("Court"), this Court
15	HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:
16	1. On order of the presiding judge, or his designee, session of this court may be held
17	anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from
18	October 22, 2021 to November 21, 2021, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));
19	2. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise
20	would expire from October 22, 2021 to November 21, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the court
21	may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a
22	criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).

24	THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY and any provision of the Thirty-First
25	General Order not amended herein remains in effect.
