13	made by the Superior Court of Madera County ("Court"), this court HEREBY FINDS AND
14	ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:
15	1. On order of the presiding judge, or his designee, session of this court may be held
16	anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from April
17	25, 2022 to May 25, 2022, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));
18	2. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise
19	would expire from April 25, 2022 to May 25, 2022, inclusive, any judge of the court may
20	extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a
21	criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
22	THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY and any provision of the Thirty-
23	First, Thirty-Ninth, Fortieth and Forty-Second General Orders not amended herein remains in
24	effect.
