9 **FORTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ORDER RE: MADERA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT
MITIGATION OF THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**


10 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the July
11 21, 2022 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial
12 Council of California, issued in response to the July 19, 2022 request for an emergency order
13 made by the Superior Court of Madera County ("Court"), this court HEREBY FINDS AND
14 ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

15 1. On order of the presiding judge, or his designee, session of this court may be held
16 anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from July
17 27, 2022 to August 26, 2022, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));

18 2. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise
19 would expire from July 27, 2022 to August 26, 2022, inclusive, any judge of the court may
20 extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a
21 criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).

22 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY **and** any provision of the Forty-
23 Seventh General Order not amended herein remains in effect.
