(Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1)); 17 18 2. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from August 27, 2022 to September 26, 2022, inclusive, any judge of the court 19 may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a 20 criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)). 21 22 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY and any provision of the Forty-23 Seventh General Order not amended herein remains in effect. 24
