10 **MITIGATION OF THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**


11 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the
12 September 21, 2022 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the
13 Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the September 20, 2022 request for an
14 emergency order made by the Superior Court of Madera County ("Court"), this court
15 HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

16 1. On order of the presiding judge, or his designee, session of this court may be held
17 anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from
18 September 27, 2022 to October 27, 2022, inclusive. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));

19 2. In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise
20 would expire from September 27, 2022 to October 27, 2022, inclusive, any judge of the court
21 may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a
22 criminal trial by not more than 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).

23 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY and any provision of the Forty-
24 Seventh General Order not amended herein remains in effect.
