The Superior Court of California, Madera County is a unified superior court, served by ten judges, one family support commissioner, and one traffic commissioner.

Assignments: A half-day assignment is from **8:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.** or **1:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.** A full-day assignment is from **8:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m.**

Hearings start promptly at 8:30 AM for morning sessions and 1:15 PM or 1:30 PM for afternoon sessions.

Contractors are required to check in with the coordinator by **8:15 a.m.** for morning and full-day assignments, and by **1:15 p.m.** for half-day afternoon assignments. Contractors must also check in again after their morning and afternoon assignments are complete for potential re-assignment(s).

 - Criminal Mandatory Settlement Conferences
- Dept. 45: Monday - Friday
 - Case type: Criminal law & motion, settlement, and trial.

- Case type: Civil law & motion, settlement, trial, and CARE Court
- Ex parte Hearings: 37, 40, 44, Room 411B Monday – Friday beginning at 8:15 a.m.
