#### **Public Comment Updates to Proposed Amendments to Local Rules**

#### SUMMARY:

The proposed amendments to the Court's Local Rules ("Rules"), are part of the Court's continuing effort to review, correct, and update its Rules as needed.

Below is the addendum to the amendments of proposed local rules, based on public comments received by the Court, with deletions noted in strikethrough and additions noted in underline.

Division 3 CIVIL RULES

**Chapter 1** General Provisions

3.1.8 Petitions for Appointment of Temporary Guardian. All petitions for temporary guardianship orders shall be scheduled for hearing no sooner than the second court day after the filing of the petition in order for a determination to be made as to whether a referral to the local child welfare agency pursuant to Probate Code 1513(b) is necessary. Note that Local Rule 7.1.7 does not apply to the filing of petitions for temporary guardianship orders. (Effective 1/1/24)

# DIVISION 7 PROBATE, ADOPTION, AND RELATED MATTERS Chapter 1 <u>Probate Filings and Orders</u>

7.1.7 <u>Time for Submitting Papers and Orders</u>. <u>Except for petitions for temporary guardianship orders (as noted in Local Rule 3.1.8), all papers relating to a probate hearing, including the proposed order prepared by the moving party, shall be filed or lodged with the Clerk at least four (4) court days before the date of hearing.
